Navigating Turbulent Times: AI and Data Protection Regulation in a Time of Change

Abstract

The US national strategy on AI has taken a rapid turn to a race for dominance and for limits on regulation. What impacts do these developments have on data protection governance, AI trust frameworks and international cooperation? How are staff at organizations addressing the expanded appetite for risk as product leads pursue AI strategies? Is privacy engineering a key enabler of rapid progress or is it perceived as a hindrance? FPF CEO Jules Polonetsky will share first hand feedback from his experience working with privacy and AI governance and policy leads at 200 member companies, as well as with leaders in schools systems and government agencies.

Jules has served for 15 years as CEO of the Future of Privacy Forum, a global non-profit organization that serves as a catalyst for privacy leadership and scholarship, advancing principled data practices in support of emerging technologies.

Jules has led the development of numerous codes of conduct and best practices, assisted in the drafting of data protection legislation and presented expert testimony with agencies and legislatures around the world. He is an IAPP Westin Emeritus Fellow and the 2023 recipient of the IAPP Leadership Award.

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
